upstairs and I wanted a walk-in pantry. So, we slowly whittled it all down to what we did and didn't want with the guidance of the architect. We worked well together, we discussed everything, and they gave me choices which made it easy for me. They did all the work, and I just had to choose what I liked."

And picking what she liked was not a big ask for Wendy, who owned and operated The Accessory Shop on Stafford Street for more than 40 years before she retired just before Christmas.

"I really enjoyed that part of it. I was always buying and selling for the shop so I am used to choosing things. Whether it's right or not I don't know - but I love it."

Given Wendy and Tim's brief, the team at Desmond Prisk Architects designed a home that would work well for the couple's everyday lives on the upper level and honour Wendy's request to live upstairs, but could also comfortably accommodate visiting friends and family on the ground floor when needed, allowing both groups privacy. Once completed, the development consisted of two conjoined properties, each on two levels with generous outdoor spaces on each level. The two houses are similar in layout and form but with subtle differences that acknowledge each unit's slightly different orientation and outlook. The planning of both houses is such that you are hardly aware of the dominant local

## CONTEMPORARY living

You could easily lose an hour or two watching the world go by from Wendy Smith's living room.

The lifelong South Canterbury resident lives on The Terrace in a two-storey townhouse overlooking the bustling port of Timaru.

'There's always something interesting going on and something to look at. Sometimes you don't look and suddenly it goes a bit dark, and you look and there's a big ship right in front of you. And today they lifted a tugboat up onto the wharf. I can also see right up the middle of the harbour which is nice."

The three-bedroom, three-bathroom home embodies resortstyle living in the heart of Timaru and boasts magnificent views of Caroline Bay and the Southern Alps in the distance, along with glimpses of the Timaru skyline.

However, the view is not new for Wendy, who lived in a larger 3-storey home next door to her townhouse before she decided to downsize several vears ago.

"I used to live next door and I had an empty section for many years, and I thought I better do something with it. So luckily before Covid happened, I employed a great architect to see what we could fit on the site.

That great architect was the talented team at Desmond Prisk Architects who were tasked with producing architectural options for the elevated site that would include a new home for Wendy and her husband Tim, as well as second property that could be utilised as a development opportunity.

form of the large white dome on the edge of the port.

The second townhouse was sold to another family, and Wendy and Tim made the big move from next door six months ago.

"We just wheelbarrowed all of our stuff over. I had to sell a lot of stuff on marketplace and whittle down what I wanted to keep which was a mammoth task for me. You don't really need a lot of stuff but when you have a big house you have to fill it. My new home is easier to manage. I love antiques and I have a mix of new furniture and a few antique bits thrown in it.

The team at Desmond Prisk Architects described Wendy's new home as contemporary in its styling, with clean lines and a restrained exterior pallet of materials.

To make the most of the views the home features an abundance of glazed areas, with a raised area of the roof with highlevel glazing that gives the living spaces great natural light and afternoon sun. The home also features a wooden floating staircase which is accentuated with three large paper light lanterns, and two moderr outdoor spaces that are the perfect spot for entertaining, enjoying a good book or relaxing in the outdoor spa.

## Heritage Tomatoes

Many may know Kevin Sepie as the Lavender Fields man, but he's also a man who knows a lot about heritage tomatoes.

Kevin started selling heritage tomatoes about six years ago in late spring alongside the lavender plants at Lavender Fields. "They're very popular," he says. "There's a general enthusiasm for all heritage vegetables. People want to get back to the old school growing in their gardens."

Kevin has around 20 varieties of tomato plants and after selling some he just focuses on growing his own during the summer. And he doesn't sell tomatoes, he eats them, shares them, preserves them. So what are the best heritage varieties to try?

"Well, they all tend to have a richer flavour than the ones you might pick off the supermarket shelf. Jaune Flamme is very popular says Kevin. An almost apricot coloured smaller tomato with a rich, sweet flavour. Sunrise Bumblee is also smallish and a bright, yellow



orange colour. Kevin himself prefers the smaller to medium sized tomatoes but he says Brandywine beefsteak varieties are also very popular. When it comes to heritage tomatoes there really is a lot of choice and you may be surprised at the colours, shapes and flavours."

As for growing advice Kevin is clear – the key thing is not to plant them outside until we are well past the frosts. But beyond that – tomatoes are actually hardier plants than many of us think. Generally with good watering, free draining soil and compost they should do well.

"My father used to always take the laterals out," says Kevin. "It can help air circulate and that's good. But they will still do well without removing laterals."

Plants can be susceptible to aphids and Kevin suggests tobacco plants as a good natural solution – the leaves have a sticky underside which attracts aphids, so they act like a natural fly paper.

## Panera Creamy Tomato Soup

NGREDIENTS 2 tablespoons olive oil 4 garlic cloves, minced 1 large yellow onion, sliced 2 (28 oz) cans San Marzano peeled tomatoes 1 cup chicken stock (or vegetable stock) 1 tablespoon sugar 1/4 cup heavy cream 8 large fresh basil leaves, roughly chopped 1/4 teaspoon dried oregano 1/2 teaspoon of red pepper flakes kosher salt and freshly ground black pepper, to taste 1/3 cup shredded parmesan cheese, optional

1. In a heavy bottomed pot (or dutch oven), heat olive oil over medium-high heat. Add garlic and saute for 30 seconds - until fragrant. Add onion and cook, stirring as needed, until translucent - about 8 minutes.

2. Add San Marzano peeled tomatoes (juice and all), chicken stock, and sugar. Bring to a low simmer. Cook uncovered, for 12 minutes or until it has thickened

3. Add the heavy cream, basil, oregano, red pepper flakes and season to taste with salt and peppe


4. Using an immersion blender (or carefully transfer soup to a blender), puree soup until there are no large chunks left.


OPTIONAL: stir in parmesan cheese and serve topped with buttery croutons.


Store in an airtight container in the fridge for up to 5 days or in the freezer for up to 3 months.


#### 6. Put your legs up the wall


